

**Inland Wetland Commission
Special Meeting – September 9, 2008
Inland Wetland Application for installation of a concrete pad for Naugatuck Glass
Company located on 451 Church Street (IW#08-09), Naugatuck, CT. Applicant:

The Commission met at the property, to convene the special meeting, to consider the Inland Wetland Application for Inland Wetland Application for installation of a concrete pad for Naugatuck Glass Company located on 451 Church Street (IW#08-09), Naugatuck, CT. Applicant: Naugatuck Glass Co.

Charles Croce, PE, the applicant's representative, led the group into the site, identifying the proposed location from the concrete pad and roxidizer unit. He explained how the 900 square foot concrete pad would be built, where the 5 foot wide gravel filter strip would be located, how utilities would be provided from overhead (over Hop Brook), and the locations of the ornamental fence, stockpile of excavated material, silt fences, landscaping and dewatering area, if necessary. He explained to the commission how no wetland or watercourse would be altered by the project and stated that the total impacts to the upland review area would be approximately 600 square feet.

The group then walked to the opposite side of the property and examined a roxidizer unit, concrete pad and ornamental fence built previously, one that would resemble one currently proposed by the applicant. It was explained by the applicant that the new unit would be larger.

No other discussion took place.

The special meeting recessed at 6:05 P.M. to the October 1, 2008 meeting.
