**This program is open to Naugatuck Residents ONLY, Residential Materials ONLY.** NO construction or remodeling materials will be accepted from contractors. Only small amounts of sheet rock, shingles, plaster, and deck or porch wood will be accepted from residents. Bag small pieces of these materials in heavy trash bags.

A permit is required for use of this drop-off center, you can obtain one by bringing your car registration to the Public Works Office, 246 Rubber Ave.

Refrigerator / Freezer / AC / Dehumidifier	\$10.00 ea
Stuffed Chair / Twin Mattress	\$5.00 ea
Queen Mattress & Box Spring / Love Seat	\$10.00 ea
Couch	\$15.00 ea
Tire (Small / Car)	\$5.00 ea
Tire (Medium to Large Truck / Oversized)	\$10.00 ea and up
Appliance	\$5.00 ea
TV / Computer / Electronics	No Charge

### **Bulk Waste Cost Per Load – Excluding Items Listed Above:**

Single Item – Small Items Only	\$5.00
Per Load Charge (Average Pick-Up Truck)	\$25.00
Extra Large Load	\$50.00 and up

### ***NO CHARGE for the following items - some exceptions if in large quantities:***

*Brush, Branches & Christmas Trees, Leaves (Paper bags only), Auto Batteries, Motor Oil, Oil Filters, Antifreeze, Hydraulic & Home Heating Oil, Transmission Fluid, Cooking Oil & Grease, Phone Books, Cardboard, Newspaper, Magazines, Catalogs, Glass Bottles, #1 through #7 Plastic Bottles & Food Containers, Oversized Plastic Objects, Metal Food & Beverage Cans, Aerosol Cans, Juice & Milk Paperboard Cartons, Juice Boxes, Junk Mail, Boxboard (Cereal box style cardboard), School, Computer, & Office Paper, Books (Hard covers removed), Fluorescent Bulbs, Rechargeable Batteries, Fire Extinguishers, Propane Tanks, Helium Tanks. No Styrofoam, No Paint, No Hazardous Waste.*

***Please note: Load size and charge is determined by the Recycling Center attendant and is not negotiable. Loads where size cannot be determined will be charged the maximum amount, excessively large loads may be charged extra.***

***Payment by cash or check – Make check payable to “Borough of Naugatuck”***

**The Borough will revoke privileges to use the Transfer Station for any resident who refuses to adhere to this fee schedule or causes a disturbance at the site.**
