

Recycling Center News

The Rubber Avenue Recycling Center is open year round Thursday & Saturday 8 AM to 2 PM (Bulk Trash portion closed in winter)

All the curbside recyclables listed below are accepted at the Recycling Center plus motor oil, oil filters, antifreeze, home heating oil, diesel fuel, car batteries, propane tanks, brush & branches, leaves & grass in paper bags, electronics including TV's, computers, stereos, & fax machines, fluorescent bulbs, rechargeable batteries, cell phones, cooking oil & grease, & phone books.

No charge for all recyclables listed above.

Grass clippings, leaves, and pine needles cannot be added to the regular trash they must be recycled. Bring to the Center in 30 gallon paper bags or use special curbside collections, 3 weeks in the fall and 1 week in the spring. No charge.

Brush, branches, and Christmas trees are accepted at the Recycling Center in limited amounts – residents should make alternative arrangements for large trees or lot clearing materials. No charge.

Tires are accepted for a fee.

Bulk Trash & Scrap Metal furniture, appliances, large items, all accepted for a fee, payable by cash or check. *The Bulk Trash portion of the Center closes for the winter mid-December and re-opens late March.*

Tin & Steel Cans & Aerosol Cans	No Mirrors, No Window Panes
Boxboard i.e. Cereal, Shoe, Pasta, & Gift Boxes (Remove plastic)	No Motor Oil or Chemical Bottles or Containers, No Paint Cans
