The Rubber Avenue Recycling Center is open year round Thursday & Saturday 8 AM to 2 PM (Bulk Trash portion closed in winter)

All the <u>curbside recyclables</u> listed below are accepted at the Recycling Center plus <u>motor oil</u>, <u>oil</u> <u>filters</u>, <u>antifreeze</u>, <u>home heating oil</u>, <u>diesel fuel</u>, <u>car batteries</u>, <u>propane tanks</u>, <u>brush & branches</u>, <u>leaves & grass in paper bags</u>, <u>electronics including TV's</u>, <u>computers</u>, <u>stereos</u>, <u>& fax machines</u>, <u>fluorescent bulbs</u>, <u>rechargeable batteries</u>, <u>cell phones</u>, <u>cooking oil & grease</u>, <u>& phone books</u>. No charge for all recyclables listed above.

<u>Grass clippings, leaves, and pine needles</u> cannot be added to the regular trash they must be recycled. Bring to the Center in 30 gallon paper bags or use special curbside collections, 3 weeks in the fall and 1 week in the spring. No charge.

<u>Brush</u>, <u>branches</u>, <u>and Christmas trees</u> are accepted at the Recycling Center in limited amounts – residents should make alternative arrangements for large trees or lot clearing materials. No charge.

Tires are accepted for a fee.

<u>Bulk Trash & Scrap Metal</u> furniture, appliances, large items, all accepted for a fee, payable by cash or check. *The Bulk Trash portion of the Center closes for the winter mid-December and re-opens late March.*
