Dog Park Rules

- Dogs must be accompanied by and under the control of their owners or dog walkers.
- Dogs must be at least 4 months old.
- If your dog becomes aggressive, please leave the park for everyone's safety.
- Leashed dogs may feel threatened when off-leash dogs greet them. Please unleash your dog in the entrance area.
- Please carry a leash at all times (a lead no longer than 6 feet is suggested).
- Please use the smaller fenced area for your small or timid dog.
- DOGS MUST BE LICENSED.
- The dog handler is responsible for the acts and conduct of their dog at all times.
- Please see all rules posted at the park entrance.
- Sick or aggressive dogs are not allowed
- Children under the age of 16 must be supervised by an adult.
- If you bring treats for your dog, PLEASE have them in sealed containers (unless you want 20 dogs jumping in your treat bag!).

Doggie Do's and Don't

Please remember the rules are in place to

keep everyone happy and healthy. Please follow them.

- Don't smoke or eat inside the park.
- Please no liquor in the park
- Do be sure your dog has current vaccinations.
- Don't bring in glass containers or bottles.
- Don't use prong, choke or training collars. Gentle Leaders are allowed.
- Do be considerate of other park users.
- Do keep you dog in sight and under your control at all times.
- Don't bring a female dog in season.
- Don't bring more than two dogs per person
- Don't bring bikes, strollers, baby carriages, skaleboards, skales, rollerblades and molorized yehicles in the park.
- Do bring water and a dish for your dog.
- Do not bring pets, other than dogs, into the park
 Do fill holes and repair damage caused by your
- Do clean up after your dog, or any other dogs, whose owners may have forgotten.
- Do be sure your dog has current vaccinations.
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Parents are strictly liable for the actions of their children.

The dog park is closed during mowing and other needed maintenance.
