- 1) The pool will be installed in accordance with the applicable sections of the Building Code.
- 2) All electrical work will be performed in accordance with the 2003 IRC, 2005 NEC, which is also covered in the handout. Pool alarms are required on ALL installations.
- 3) A minimum four foot high barrier SHALL be installed around/at the access to the pool. The gates shall comply with the Building Code and as provided in the handout. The gates shall be self-closing, self-latching with the latch inaccessible to small children. *READ THE HANDOUT.*

CHAPTER 41 IRC SWIMMING POOL SAFETY DEVICES
CGS PA-140 SWIMMING POOL ALARM

Every person owning land on which there is situated a swimming pool, which contains twenty four (24) inches or more of water in depth at any point, shall erect and maintain thereon an adequate enclosure surrounding the property or pool area, sufficient to make such body of Water inaccessible to small children. In addition to the required enclosure, a pool alarm is required by Public Act 99-140 that states when a person or object of 15 lbs. enters the water the pool alarm must emit a sound of at least 50 decibels.

- 1) There shall be appropriate safeguards in place during construction to prevent accidents. This shall be the owner or contractors responsibility, one shall be designated. Any temporary guards shall meet the intent of AG105.6-temporary enclosures.
- 2) All permanent enclosures shall comply with AG105.6.
- 3) All pool circulation shall comply with the Building Code and the appropriate sections of the Public Health Code.
- 4) Any engineering calculations shall be provided prior to the issuance of the permit.

I, the owner, hereby agree with the above and comply with Section 421 of the State of Connecticut Building Code concerning pool safety devices as well as the Connecticut General Statutes PA 99-140.
