Declaration of Personal Property - 2022 Grand List

Notice is hereby given that ALL PERSONAL PROPERTY subject to taxation *MUST* be reported to the Assessor on or before November 1, 2022.

Personal Property Subject to Taxation Includes:

Property used in the operation of any business such as machinery and equipment, commercial furniture and fixtures, leasehold improvements, computer equipment, vending machines, supplies, unregistered vehicles, horses, farm tools and machinery, mechanics tools, and all other taxable property located or otherwise situated within the municipal boundaries of the Borough of Naugatuck as of October 1, 2022. *Real estate and registered motor vehicles should NOT be reported.*

Deadline for Reporting is November 1, 2022

The Assessor for good cause may grant an extension of up to 45 days. To obtain an extension, you **must** request the same in writing not later than November 1, 2022. Failure to report your personal property in a timely manner will result in a penalty equal to 25% of the assessed valuation of such property as required by Connecticut Law in Section 12-42.

Declaration forms to report personal property will be mailed by October 1st to those businesses that have previously reported. New businesses and those who do not receive a declaration form should contact the Assessor's Office.

We encourage complete and timely reporting and are pleased to assist taxpayers who have questions regarding the proper reporting of personal property.
