WHEREAS, a public informational meeting was held on Thursday May 30, 2013 At 7:00 p.m. at which meeting residents and interested parties had the opportunity to voice their concerns; and

WHEREAS, the Central Naugatuck Valley Council of Governments has selected this project as a regional priority and to utilize federal funds for design, right-of-way and construction activities; and

WHEREAS, the project is located on a municipally owned road, all phases (preliminary engineering, right-of-way and construction) will be performed by the Borough of Naugatuck or its consultant utilizing 80% federal funds, 10% state funds and 10% Borough of Naugatuck funds for all phases; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Burgesses has considered the concerns of the residents from the public information meeting and finds that the proposed Major Reconstruction of Cross Street is in the best interest of the Borough of Naugatuck, and will promote the health, safety and general welfare of its residents and provide for convenience and safety of the motoring public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Borough of Naugatuck based on the above information, and by virtue of this resolution, hereby fully support the proposed Major Reconstruction of Cross Street project.
