Chief Ellen Murray, NFD mad a motion to accept the previous minutes. John Deer seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

The Emergency Manager made his report. He discussed current CERT manpower levels and discussed upcoming training options some CERT members volunteered for concerning care

of groups to try to prevent PTSD. He then discussed changed in funding for CERT concerning CPR and First Aid training. He then mentioned an October 15, 2015 meeting for Region 5 emergency planning in Litchfield he will be attending.

Vice Chairman Jay Pugliese then talked about the elections of officers for NEMAC. Fran Dambowski, EMD nominated Vice Chairman Det. Jay Pugliese for the office of Chairman. John Deer seconded it. There were no other nominees. The Secretary cast 1 vote for Det. Jay Pugliese for Chairman of the NEMAC/LEPC. Det. Jay Pugliese is elected Chairman

The Council then considered the position of Vice Chairman. Al Raymond, Secretary nominated John Deer for Vice Chairman. Fran Dambowski seconded the nomination. There were no other nominees. The Secretary cast one vote for John Deer for Vice Chairman of the NEMAC/LEPC. John Deer is elected Vice Chairman.

The Council then considered the position of Secretary. There were no nominees and the current Secretary does not wish reelection. The issue was tabled for further consideration.

The meeting then considered the upcoming 10/21/15 state wide emergency exercise. The EMD filled the Council on an outline of the upcoming exercise and some issues concerning Naugatuck's participation. There was extended discussion.
