The Golf Commission meeting was held on Monday, April 13, 2009 at 6:30 pm at the Naugatuck Town Hall, 229 Church Street, Naugatuck, Ct.

**Secretary's Report:** Minutes of March meeting were reviewed. Jeremy Lennon made a motion to accept, Brian Wright seconded, accepted unanimously.

The request made by St. Hedwig's Church Golf Tournament at the March meeting was approved by an email vote as follows "In light of the poor economy and in the best interest of Hop Brook Golf Course, Brian Wright makes a motion to allow the St. Hedwig's Church Golf Tournament for Saturday May 30, 2009 for a shotgun start at 1:00 pm for a minimum of 64 golfers to a maximum of 72 golfers with the condition that this would not be an automatic tournament and will be subject to a yearly review by the Golf Commission", Nancy Barton seconded, approved unanimously.

Brian Wright made a motion to adjourn at 7:15 pm., Jeremy Lennon seconded, approved unanimously.
