AUGUST 10, 2009

The Golf Course Commission meeting was held on Monday, August 10, 2009 at the Naugatuck Town Hall, 229 Church St., Naugatuck, Ct.

Jeremy Lennon was appointed as a voting member.

Secretary's Report: Minutes of July meeting were read. Motion to accept was made by Jeremy Lennon and seconded by Glenn Petelle. Unanimously accepted.

Treasurer's Report: Ray Lennon presented a treasurer's report. Jeremy Lennon made a motion to accept and 2nd by Glenn Petelle. Approved unanimously.

Pro Shop Update: Ray Lennon reported that there was no new business. Paul Grant is still looking for 2-3 new timbers around the walk way. The old ones were painted white, but some need replacing. Pat Corbett will talk to Joe Malay about storage for green covers, fourth and fifth hole mowing, and signs for the road about cart crossings.

Golf Commissioners Concerns: Jeremy Lennon asked about threesomes on Sunday mornings, what happens if one person drops out? Pro Shop has the discretion to allow a twosome to continue. The three additional panels for tee markers have been completed and shipped. Pat Corbett has not heard back from Mayor Mezzo about emails Pat had sent. Pat Corbett is going to talk to Joe Malay about the back of the 1st green to see what can be done since retirements. Pat Corbett received a complaint about a Sunday, where someone was denied a cart with a bag cover on it. Please have Paul Grant remind staff about allowing carts not in rotation if asked for. At next meeting, please ask Paul Grant to look into purchasing golf bag covers for the remainder of carts. Also we will ask Paul Grant to look into purchasing plastic sign holders for the carts. If we can develop a slow play policy, we would be able to post in the cart as well as any other advertisements or announcements.
