

GOLF COMMISSION MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 14, 2009

The Golf Course Commission meeting was held on Monday, September 14, 2009 at 6:30 pm at the Naugatuck Town Hall, 229 Church St. Naugatuck, Ct.

Commissioners attending: Pat Corbett, Jeremy Lennon, Gary Myers, and Nancy Barton.

Commissioner not attending: Glenn Petelle, and Brian Wright.

Others attending: Paul Grant, Joe Malay.

Secretary's Report: Minutes of August meeting were read. Motion to accept was made by Jeremy Lennon and 2nd by Gary Myers. Unanimously accepted.

Treasurer's Report: Paul Grant presented a treasurer's report. Gary Myers made a motion to accept and 2nd by Jeremy Lennon. Approved unanimously.

Agenda:

Pro Shop Update: Paul Grant reported that the Jesse Camille's tournament did not run smoothly this year. Larry Erickson did not communicate with Paul Grant about the low numbers, and he did not get a liqueur permit. Also, one new cart was wrecked, so Paul will be presenting a bill to Larry about the damage. We are waiting to hear from Mark Magas about his tournament rain date. Next year when the commission is discussing rain dates for tournaments, we need to be aware of what else is scheduled so we do not schedule tournaments and rain dates with consecutive weekend dates.

Golf Commissioners Concerns: Mixed league asked for 8 tee times on October 4 from 1:00-2:00 for their annual turkey shoot. Nancy Barton made a motion to accept, Jeremy Lennon second the motion. Passed unanimously. Ladies League from Waterbury asked for tee times from 9:00-10:00 on October 5 for a small tournament. Nancy Barton made a motion to accept, Gary Myers seconded the motion. Passed unanimously. Christ the King Church asked for tee times from 9:00-10:00 on October 3 for a tournament. The commission approved the times of 8:30-9:30 if a minimum of 32 is paid for. Gary Myers made a motion to accept and Nancy Barton second the motion. Passed unanimously. The Tuesday night mixed league asked for an increase in their league for the upcoming year. Pat Corbett tabled the request until February meeting about leagues. Pat Corbett announced that Jeremy Lennon and Gary Myers have been appointed as full time voting members and Brian Wright has been appointed as an alternate. Pat Corbett will be discussing with Lineweber Brothers about alternative for the back of 1st green. Joe Malay will be meeting with Jim Stewart about the back of the 1st green as well as the cart rail. Pat Corbett met with Rocco Corso about decals for the golf carts; they are approximately \$5.00 a piece. The commission recommended purchasing about 50 of them. The commission asked Paul Grant to look into the price for purchasing the plastic sign holders for the remainder carts. Jeremy Lennon asked about putting a bell on the alternate side of #4. Joe Malay said it could be done. Paul Grant reported that there will be no starters or rangers beginning October 5th.

Nancy Barton asked when tee times will no longer be required. Paul Grant responded November. Nancy Barton made a motion that after Labor Day, a twosome can be allowed to play after 11:00 am with a tee time on the weekend. Gary Myers second the motion. Approved unanimously. Joe Malay reported that aeration began today and would finish Wednesday. Joe Malay made a request from the commission to fund conference money for training for maintain his Class A certification. It would cost up to \$2500. The committee approved \$900 to begin the process, but would like final figures for approval.

Motion to adjourn at 7:55 pm made by Nancy Barton and seconded by Pat Corbett. Unanimously accepted.
