

PARK COMMISSION MEETING
MARCH 10, 2009

The regular monthly meeting was held on March 10, 2009 at the Park Department office on Rubber Ave.

The meeting was called to order at 5:17 pm.

Voted: Unanimously on a motion by Jay Kuczenski and seconded by Mr. Healy to accept the minutes of the February meeting , amended to read, “**Voted:** Unanimously on a motion by Jay Kuczenski to rescind a previous motion to invite all youth organizations to the April meeting and wait till the new guidelines are drafted. Seconded by Mike Falcha.”

Business:

Superintendent’s Report: The equipment, small to large pieces, is being worked on. The ticket booth is coming along.

Voted: Unanimously on a motion by Jay Kuczenski, seconded by Ron Plasky, to accept Fran’s report.

-Melissa Leonard from the general public brought in information regarding the use of organic fertilizer to be used a Gunntown Rd. Fran will look into the matter.

-Joe Campos from soccer informed the commission that they will once again be providing the Park Department the field paint for their soccer fields. Also there will be a camp for all ages involved with soccer in the coming season.

-All field assignments will be discussed in the future.

-Pat wants to take a ride on a weekend to all the parks and view any potential issues that can be addressed to the Park Department staff to fix or clean up.
