

PARK COMMISSION MINUTES Special Meeting

The wall will be dismantled and placed at the Heights until a proper place to reconstruct the wall can be reached.

Sub Committee:

Pitch, Hit and Run competition went well. A child from P.J. Foley will be representing the town in St. Luis for the championship.
