

GOLF COMMISSION MINUTES
OCTOBER 20, 2008

The Golf Course Commission meeting was held on Monday, October 20, 2008 at 6:30 pm at the Naugatuck Town Hall, 229 Church St, Naugatuck, Ct.

Commissioners attending: Pat Corbett, Jeremy Lennon, Brian Wright, Gary Myers and Nancy Barton.

Commissioners not attending: Joe Marques, Glenn Petelle and Alan Crosswait.

Others attending: Paul Grant.

Jeremy Lennon, Brian Wright and Gary Myers were appointed as voting members.

Secretary's Report: Minutes of September meeting were reviewed. Brian Wright made a motion to accept, Jeremy Lennon seconded. Unanimously accepted.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer's report was presented. Paul Grant gave a revised August YTD so August YTD is up \$250 whole overall up by \$1100. Brian Wright made a motion to accept. Gary Myers seconded. Unanimously accepted.

Pro Shop Update: Paul Grant reposted 6 new golf carts have been ordered and should be ready for April. Bag covers have been ordered for between \$150-\$160 a piece. Paul asked about keeping the twosome rule in effect through October. Commission said yes because in November tee times stop, so to keep consistent with year rules, keep in effect through October. No starters or rangers during the week. Covers for the 2nd & 3rd greens have been ordered at \$900 per cover. Paul, Hank Witkowski and town engineer reviewed the curve from the 9th hole to restructure to see if new carts can be saved from abuse on that turn.

Golf Commissioners Concerns: Joe Marques has officially resigned from the Golf Commission. Mayor Bronko is looking into a replacement. Pat Corbett will recommend Brian Wright as permanent replacement. The Congregational Church in Naugatuck requested a raffle gift from the commission for their holiday bazaar. Nancy Barton made a motion that donations for raffle prizes will be limited to requests for consideration from Golf tournament sponsors. Gary Myers seconded. Approved unanimously. Brian Wright made a motion to adjourn at 7:25 pm. Gary Myers seconded the motion. Approved unanimously.
