Nancy Barton seconded. Unanimously approved. Pat Corbett submitted a schedule for next year's meetings. Nancy Barton asked the HBGCL to look into for next year, that if someone is to participate in kickers or low gross, that the player needs to be playing with at least one other person to attest to the card. Jeremy Lennon inquired about Gold yardage and slope for handicaps since the number of senior citizens is increasing and using the yellow tees. Pat Corbett would like the commissioners to think about a mandatory cart rule. Nancy Barton would like the commissioners to think about No Jeans allowed in dress code. Jeremy Lennon made a motion to adjourn at 7:20 pm. Brian Wright seconded the motion. Approved unanimously.
