Report of the Public Works Superintendent: Robert Roland told the Commission that the Brush Cutter was still being utilized throughout Town and that the drainage work on Charles Street and Pleasant Street was going well. The work on upper Hillside School steps and wall was done. The patch crew is out doing miscellaneous paving and patching. The Mason crew worked on the catch basins in the Glendale neighborhood. Micro paving started the week of 9/20/10 in the Glendale neighborhood. Milling and paving will start the first and second week of October. The winter equipment preparation has begun and the salt and sand bids went out.

Director of Public Works: Jim Stewart, Bids are in for the David water line service to homes, sealing town hall, cart lifters for existing trucks, motor vehicle parts & service, pool repairs, hardware, lumber & supplies, evictions, RFQ's for plumbing and electrical services. Additional bids waiting to come in are the waste oil furnace and winter sand & salt. Commissioner Ruccio was happy to see local businesses on the bid list. The 5yr capital paving plan was mailed to the commission prior to the meeting.
