Public Comment: Diamantino Rebimbas – 250 Stone Fence Road addressed the Commission about the trash not being collected at his over 4 family properties. Commissioner John Ford went over what was discussed at the previous Street Commission meetings regarding the trash collection of over 4 family properties and where the Commission stands on this issue.

Burgess, Mindy Fragoso, 68 Heritage Drive, Asked for a copy of the Minutes for the March 28, 2010 Meeting and she spoke about the private roads and the deposition of Hank Witkoski in a Court case against the Borough of Naugatuck. She told the Commission that when they study the private road collection issue that a blanket policy would be phenomenal so that some do and some don't and to also have numbers for units to be counted as the multi-family houses were and to also be frugal with the funds for Naugatuck in making this policy.

Liz Lipovsky- #236 Cherry Street Condo asked when the trash would be collected because the lease on their dumpster was up on April 30, 2010. Shelia Baummer, Recycling Coordinator informed her that the trash collection would start May 10, 2010.
