Old Business:

Collection of MSW on Private Road: Sheila Baummer passed out to the Commission the updated list of the Street and Services on Unaccepted and Private Roads. She told the Commission that Wayne Zirolli was working on the acceptance of the roads listed on the three page of her hand out and also on the roads under construction. She told the Commission that carts had been taken to Caitlin Circle and that the trash/recycling was still being picked up at Amanda Lane which has deed restrictions. The following streets that have deed restrictions do not have trash/recycling collection or other Town Services: Michael Lane/Misty Wood/North Ridge/Vidich Lane and the end of Nichols. She told the Commission that Mr. Tynan who lives on Vidich Lane had talked to Ed Carter. Mr. Tynan asked if he could bring his trash down to the Recycling Center. He is having some financial difficulties. The pros and cons were discussed about residents bringing their trash to the Recycling Center that live in Condos and on unaccepted or private roads. The Recycling Coordinator told the Commission that if you live in a condo/apartment or single family house you can use the recycling center for bulk trash and recyclables but this has never included bringing household trash.

Motion made by Commissioner Timothy Walsh and seconded by Commissioner Sebastian Barbosa to allow Mr. Tynan to do it for 6 months then the Commission will review it. He asked that the Public Works Office put it in writing to Mr. Tynan that the Street Commission had voted on it at its January 18, 2012 meeting **to give him specifically a temporary 6 months reprieve to bring his trash to the Recycling Center and not charge him.**

Sub-Committee Reports – None

Report of the Director of Public Works: Jim Stewart spoke to the Commission about the Hoadley Street Sewer Replacement Project; Nettleton Avenue Drainage Project; Maple Street Signal Project; Maple Street Bridge Project and the Rubber Avenue Bridge project and the STP-e Application for River Walk. The following bids went out: River Walk/Green Way and the Fire Works Bid for the 4th of July. He handed out to the Commission a Snow Response Policy for their review and feed back at the next meeting. Told the Commission he is working on the FEMA for the August and October storms.

Report of the Public Works Supt: - Robert Roland told the Commission the crews are working on patching the potholes and replacing and repairing street signs. The cover for the Salt/Sand Shelter is being done and a security fence is being installed at the Heights. The crews pre-treated some areas with the salt brine and it worked out well. Told the Commission 1 vehicle was down and 1 accident occurred during the January 16, 2011 snow storm. 200 tons of salt were ordered and delivered for the future snow storms.

Report of the Recycling and Solid Waste Coordinator: Sheila Baummer told the Commission that Seth Drive is now an accepted road and we were filling out an application for a grant to purchase more red carts.

Public Comment (Related to Meeting Issues) – Ed Carter told the Commission that CL&P only trims the trees and it's the responsibility of the property owner to get rid of the branches.

Motion by Commissioner Timothy Walsh and seconded by Commissioner Sebastian Barbosa to adjourn at 6:44 P.M.
