“Mulberry Cul-de-sac pine trees” Removal at 25 Sunburst discussion/Possible Action: Public Works Director Jim Stewart spoke to the Commission about the petition that was circulated by 3 neighbors requesting that the Town cut down the 25 white pine streets bordering their property. The Commissioners discussed the cost to remove the trees bordering the property.

Discussion of single stream disposal RFP. Possible referral to Borough Board: Recycling and Solid Waste Coordinator Sheila Baummer discussed the Single Stream RFP Analysis with the Commissioners. She told the Commission that the Mayor had met with her and Jim Stewart to discuss the RFP. The pros and cons were discussed about establishing a facility to bring the recyclables to ahead of time before privatization or after at the meeting. She told the Commission that the Mayor had requested an agreement from November 2013 to June 2014. Winters Brothers currently has a contract with the Town and agreed to extend their Contract from November 16, 2013 to June 30, 2014 at the rate of \$16.00 per ton.

Motion made by Commissioner Sebastian Barbosa and Commissioner Timothy Walsh to confirm the recommendation of the Recycling and Solid Waste Coordinator, the Superintendent of Streets and Public Workers Director that we enter into an Agreement with Winter Brothers till June 30, 2014.
