Mayor Hess asked everyone to join him in a moment of silence in honor of a wonderful statesman, Kevin M. DelGobbo, who passed away this week.

10. Public Comment
Parks Commission Chairwoman Linda Ramos spoke to the board regarding the project the Wingman Group was doing at Gunntown Passive Park and Nature Preserve. The Parks Commission gave the organizers of the project permission to utilize Gunntown Park. She said the Wingman Project will no longer be at Gunntown Park because there was too much of a struggle with certain individuals not associated with the Wingman Group or the Parks Commission. The Parks Commission has decided to take a more active role in promoting and overseeing the use of Gunntown Park. They will be organizing a Facebook page promoting the use of the park and events being held there. Mayor Hess said the Conservation Commission wants to take control of all open space. There is currently one burgess liaison to the Conservation Commission. There are four burgess liaisons to the Parks Commission. The mayor appointed Burgess Donald Wisniewski and Burgess Patrick Scully as liaisons to the Conservation Commission. He wants both commissions to meet with this board to discuss their plans for Gunntown Passive Park and Nature Preserve and the Andrew Mountain land.
