2. Burgess Burns led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.
3. **VOTED:** Unanimously on a motion by Burgess Jackson and seconded by Burgess Hoff that the Board of Mayor and Burgesses approve the minutes of the regular meeting of **July 5, 2017** and the special meeting of **July 18, 2017**. Each member received copies for review.
4. **VOTED:** Unanimously on a motion by Burgess Jackson and seconded by Burgess Hoff that the Board of Mayor and Burgesses approve the monthly reports of **July**. Each member received copies for review.
5. **VOTED:** Unanimously on a motion by Burgess Jackson and seconded by Burgess Scully to recess to Executive Session at **6:32 p.m.** for discussion on the following: **Real Estate Negotiations** (Chemtura), **Personnel** (Comptroller) and **Pending Litigation** inviting in Human Resources Director John Lawlor.

Mayor Hess reconvened the meeting at **7:13 p.m.**
