3. **VOTED:** Unanimously on a motion by Deputy Mayor Vitale and seconded by Burgess Rosenblatt that the tax rate for the fiscal year **July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025** on the **Borough of Naugatuck Grand List of October 1, 2023**, as amended by the Board of Assessment Appeals, be and hereby is laid at **41.79 Mills on the Dollar**, due and payable **50% July 1, 2024, 50% January 1, 2025** on real estate tax and personal property tax over \$100.00. All real estate and personal property tax bills \$99.99 or less will be due and payable **July 1, 2024**. Motor vehicle taxes are hereby laid at **32.46 Mills on the Dollar**, due and payable **50% July 1, 2024, 50% January 1, 2025** on motor vehicle taxes over \$100.00. All motor vehicle tax bills \$99.99 or less will be due and payable **July 1, 2024**.
